Question 8

Using the provided 1/5 basic bodice block provided, describe the procedures in (100 %) constructing garment patterns for the following bodice (front side only).

By method of 'slashing'.

Seam allowance is not required.

Correct pattern specifications are necessary to write down.

Design analysis:

One right shoulder dart: starting from right mid-shoulder, pointing to right bust point. One left side-seam dart: starting from side-seam which is 1/3 length from waistline, pointing to left bust point.

Distance between dart point and bust point is 1.5cm.

(In order to provide a clear diagram, the measurements are not in right proportion.)
