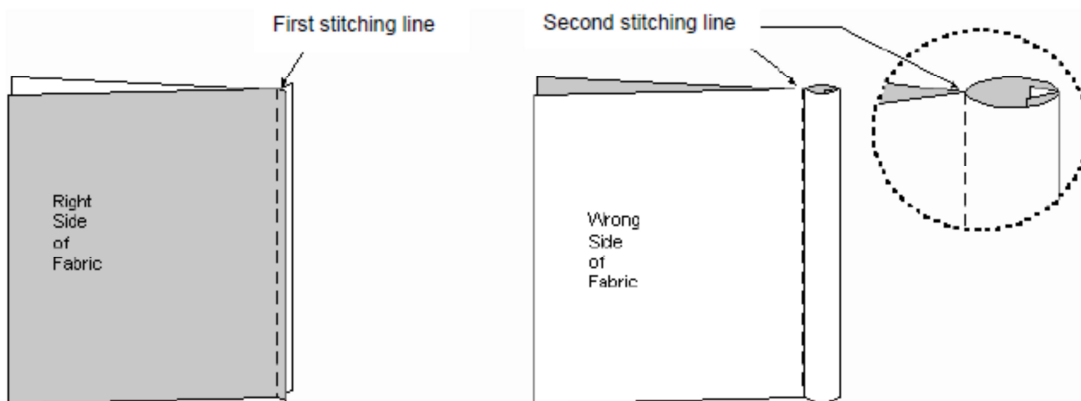

Question 5

- (a) State and describe the technique in cutting a sewing pattern. (75%)
- (b) Below tools and equipment are related to proper garments pattern drafting and sewing. (25%)
 For each of the following question, choose if the statement is TRUE or FALSE.
 In order for an answer to be TRUE, ALL parts of the statement must be true.
 On the answer book, mark down the question number with your answer.
 5% is given to a correct answer; 5% is deducted for a wrong answer; no mark will be given if no answer is provided.
- Tailor's chalk is used for decorating garment.
 - Bobbin and bobbin case are used for tracing the garment patterns.
 - A measuring tape is used for making small holes on the garment pattern.
 - Calico is used for prolonging the pattern papers.
 - A set of French curves is used for the operation of the sewing machine.

Using the provided 1/5 basic bodice block, describe the procedures in constructing garment patterns for the following bodice (front side only). (100%)

By method of 'slashing'.

Seam allowance is not required.

Correct pattern specifications are necessary to write down.

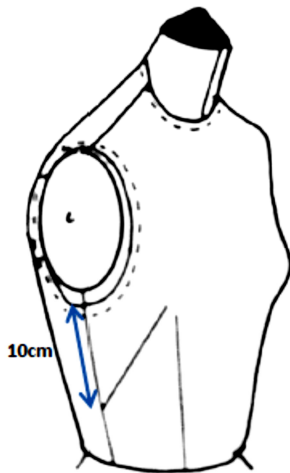
Design analysis:

Over the front side of both side-seams, each side has a side-seam dart pointing to bust point.

Measurement is indicated on the diagram

Distance between dart point and bust point is 1.5cm.

(In order to provide a clear diagram, the measurements in the diagram are not in right proportion.)
