APPENDIX III

- 1. The membership of the Institution shall consist of the following 8 classes, namely, Honorary Fellow Members, Fellow Members, Members, Licentiate Members, Graduate Members, Student Members, Affiliate Members and Companion Members, and any other classes of membership as the Executive Committee may from time to time determine.
- 2. Eligibility for various memberships shall be as follows:-
 - (a) Honorary Fellow Member

Any persons who have not less than 10 years of textile and apparel experience and who in the opinion of the Executive Committee have achieved recognised advancement in science and technology in the textile and apparel or related field. No person shall be eligible for being admitted or transferred as a Honorary Fellow Member unless nomination to Honorary Fellow Membership shall be given by 2 Voting Members to the Executive Committee.

(b) Fellow Member

Any Members who have not less than 10 years of textile and apparel or related working experience and who in the opinion of the Executive Committee have made significant contributions to the Institution and/or textile and apparel industries.

(c) Professional Member

Professional Member shall satisfy any of the following sets of requirements:-

- (i) Any persons (1) who have not less than 2 years of textile and apparel or related professional experience and (2) who have passed all examinations of the Institution including dissertation;
- Any persons (1) who have not less than 2 years of textile and apparel or related professional experience or not less than 1 year of textile and apparel or related professional experience after graduation and (2) who hold Honours degree or higher diploma approved by the Institution;
- (iii) Any persons (1) who have not less than 5 years of textile and apparel or related professional experience after graduation, (2) who have completed a diploma program of the Institution and (3) who hold appropriate Honours degree or equivalent qualification relating to textile and apparel; or
- (iv) Any persons (1) who have not less than 10 years of textile and apparel or related professional experience, (2) who have no formal qualification in the field of textile and apparel but (3) who have completed a diploma program of the Institution.
- (d) Licentiate Member

Licentiate Member shall satisfy any of the following sets of requirements:-

- (i) Any persons (1) who have not less than 2 years of textile and apparel or related working experience and (2) who have passed the higher diploma examinations of the Institution;
- (ii) Any persons (1) who have not less than 2 years of textile and apparel or related working experience or not less than 1 year of textile and apparel or related working experience after graduation and (2) who hold Honours degree or higher diploma approved by the Institution;
- (iii) Any persons (1) who have not less than 2 years of textile and apparel or related working experience, (2) who have completed a program designated by the Institution and (3) who hold appropriate Honours degree, higher diploma or equivalent qualification relating to textile and apparel;
- (iv) Any persons (1) who have not less than 5 years of textile and apparel or related working experience, (2) who have completed a program designated by the Institution and (3) who hold a certificate or diploma approved by the Institution; or
- (v) Any persons (1) who have not less than 10 years of textile and apparel or related working experience, (2) who have no formal qualification in the field of textile and apparel but (3) who have completed a program designated by the Institution.
- (e) Graduate Member

Any persons who are fresh graduates and who hold Honours degree or equivalent qualification relating to textile and apparel.

(f) Student Member

Any present students who are taking degree courses or equivalent relating to textile and apparel.

(g) Affiliate Member

Any persons who are or have been attendants of courses relating to textile and apparel or who are working in the textile and apparel industry.

(h) Companion Member

Any persons who are holding responsible positions in textile and apparel industry or commercial field, and who hold any non-textile qualifications.

3. Honorary Fellow Members, Fellow Members, Professional Members, Licentiate Members, Graduate Members and such other class of members as from time to time decided by the Executive Committee may use after their names the respective designated letters set out below or such other designated letters as from time to time determined by the Executive Committee to indicate the class of membership to which they belong:-

Such designated letters may not be used by any member who has resigned or whose name has been removed from the Register of Members.

Designated letters shall not be used by any class of membership other than in accordance with this Article.

- 4. The Executive Committee shall issue to every member (except Student Members) a certificate showing the class of membership into which he is admitted and thereafter, upon transfer to a higher or lower class of membership, a certificate showing the class of membership to which he is then transferred. The Seal shall be affixed to each such certificate of membership issued by the Executive Committee in accordance with these Articles.
- 5. The Executive Committee may from time to time, prescribe, repeal, alter and/or add to any forms of application for admission to or of nomination for membership.
- 6. Every application for membership shall be made in writing and signed by the applicant, in such form and contain such information as may be prescribed by the Executive Committee from time to time.
- 7. No person shall be admitted a member of the Institution unless he is first approved by the Executive Committee and the Executive Committee shall have full and absolute discretion as to the admission of any person to membership and shall not be called upon to give any reason thereof.
- 8. Every person shall pay the admission fee upon being admitted to membership of the Institution and thereafter, the annual subscription fee in the amount and in such manner as the Executive Committee may from time to time prescribe or determine, provided that the Executive Committee may, whenever they consider there is due cause, waive or reduce the amount of any admission fee or annual subscription fee of any member.
- 9. All admission fee and annual subscription fee paid shall not be refundable under whatever circumstances.
- 10. Unless otherwise determined by the Executive Committee, annual subscription fee shall be payable in advance. If any member shall fail to pay his annual subscription fee after the same shall have become due, notice shall be sent to him calling his attention thereto, and if he shall fail to pay the same within the deadline prescribed therein, he shall, unless otherwise determined by the Executive Committee, cease to be a member of the Institution (without having regard to Article 12), and his name shall be removed from the Register of Members of the Institution. Such member may have his membership restored upon giving explanations satisfactory to the Executive Committee and upon paying up the arrears.
- 11. A member may resign by giving at least one month's notice in advance in writing to the Institution of his intention to do so. Upon the expiration of the said notice he shall cease to be a member but he shall be liable for full payment of his annual subscription fee for the current year in which he resigns.
- 12. If any member violates any of these Articles (other than Article 10) or the bye-laws of the Institution or if his conduct is such as is likely to be prejudicial or injurious to the reputation or interests of the Institution, the Executive Committee may by resolution call upon such member to resign from the Institution forthwith and, if he fails to resign, may by resolution strike his name off the Register of Members or may suspend his membership for such period of time as the Executive Committee deems expedient Provided that at least 7 days before the meeting at which such resolution of the suspension or expulsion of the member is passed, such member shall have had notice thereof and of the intended resolution and shall at such meeting and before the passing of such resolution have had the opportunity of giving orally or in writing any representation which he may think fit.
- 13. Any person who shall for any cause cease to be a member of the Institution shall remain liable and shall pay to the Institution all monies which at the time of his ceasing to be a member shall be due from him to the Institution.
- 14. Every member shall have right:-
 - (a) To participate in all activities organised and sponsored by the Institution.
 - (b) To enjoy all facilities provided by the Institution.
 - (c) To promote the objectives of the Institution.
- 15. Subject to the Ordinance, only Voting Members shall have the right to receive notices of, to attend and vote at the general meetings of the Institution in accordance with these Articles, Provided always that the Executive Members may, if it thinks fit, from time to time permit any member other than a Voting Member to receive notices of, to attend and with the permission of the chairman of the meeting, to speak but with no entitlement to vote at such general meeting of the Institution.
- 16. The rights and privileges of a member shall be personal to himself and shall not be transferable by the act of the member or by operation of law and shall cease upon his death or upon his ceasing from any cause to be a member under the provisions of these Articles. A member shall nevertheless remain liable for and shall pay to the Institution all monies which at the time of his ceasing to be a member shall be due from him to the Institution.
